The ASSH Project is an expression of our responsibility to ensure All Saints is “fit for purpose” to serve the community creatively throughout the 21st Century and beyond.

In summary, the ASSH Project embraces:

- Installing underfloor heating and upgrading the lighting in the church
- Reducing our carbon footprint by 80% by installing a biofuels boiler and solar panels
- Replacing the crumbling 1950s vestry block with offices, appropriate toilet facilities and a community room/outdoor classroom
- Providing ramped and non-stepped access to and within all parts of the church
- Constructing a servery/kitchen area within the church
- Enabling creative worship opportunities and further community use of the church
- Opening up the West windows and door to enable natural light to enter the church - and further enhancing the Butterfield heritage of the church
- Increasing the footfall of the All Saints' campus and buildings by 100%

The total cost of this ambitious project is £2million

Our four year community and congregational pledge target is £150,000
