Thought for the weekend: Could we fit through the eye of a needle?

It was not uncommon at the time of Jesus to consider that a person who had wealth and riches was blessed by God. Sadly, it is still a view which exists today. Some people think that when things go badly for them that this is a sign of God's disapproval. Occasionally if a person suffers prolonged illness they will be heard to utter the words, 'What have I done to deserve this?' The answer is of course 'Nothing'. God does not reward us with blessings, or punish us with curses. Equally, the wealth of the rich is not a sign of God's blessing, indeed Jesus sees wealth as having the potential to divide our commitment and loyalty to God so much that the rich are in a perilous position. Considering that many of us are a lot wealthier than the folks living at the time of Jesus, we need to listen to the words of Jesus this week very carefully.

May Almighty God order our days in His peace, and grant us the gift of His Blessing. May He set us free from our anxiety, and firmly establish our minds on the foundation of His peace and tranquillity.
