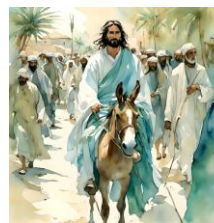

### **Thought for the week: Why "Good" Friday?**

This week, Christians remember Good Friday—the day Jesus died on the cross. The name can sound confusing. How can such a sad day be called good? In many traditions, the name reflects the sorrow of the day. In Slavonic it is called Heavy Friday. In Arabic, it is the Friday of the Passions. In the Syriac tradition, it is the Friday of Sadness. All these names remind us of Jesus' suffering and death. And they are right. This is a hard and painful day. It speaks of loss, injustice, and grief. So why do we call it Good Friday?

Christians believe it is good because of what God does through it. On the cross, Jesus shows the depth of God's love. Through his death comes forgiveness, hope, and new life. What looks like defeat becomes the victory over death. A new life. In the Assyrian tradition, Friday once called the Sixth Day, came to be called 'rūota, meaning evening or sunset. When Jesus died, it felt like darkness had come. But sunset is not the end. Morning always follows. This reminds us that even when we walk through the darkest valley, we are not alone, for the light of the risen Christ is with us, and the night will not have the final word. **Fr Ninus**
