**Thought for the weekend: Alleluia! Christ is risen - He is risen indeed Alleluia!**

Easter is the greatest of all Christian feasts, and the happy season of Eastertide lasts 50 days from Easter Day until the Feast of Pentecost. St Gregory of Nazianzus said that Easter was 'like the sun among the stars' of the other festivals. It is the heart of the sacred calendar, around which all the other festivals have meaning and purpose. Today is the summit of the Christian year, the fact that Christ is risen shows that God will never leave us, bringing good out of conflict, suffering and death. Easter tells us that just as Christ is risen, so too we can expect to be raised with him to eternal life. In this way we can begin to understand that death is not the end, rather it is only the beginning, Christ is with us forever. As late Vaclav Havel said, "Hope is not the conviction that something will turn out well, but the certainty that something makes sense, regardless of how it turns out". In the wonderful book Pilgrim's Progress, John Bunyan writes, "Then Christian gave three leaps for joy, and went on his way singing" after his burden fell off his back as he stood in front of the cross. The burden rolled down the hill into the empty sepulchre and was never seen again. Easter is a time for joyful leaps and singing hearts. May we join Christian in his celebration.

Risen Lord Jesus, as Mary Magdalene met you in the garden on the morning of your resurrection, so may we meet you today and every day:
