### **Thought for the weekend - Why did Jesus provide so much wine for the wedding guests?**

In the Holy Gospel reading this weekend Jesus makes wine, lots of it, for the guests at the wedding. He made far more than anybody needed. It is over the top and could easily be criticised as wasteful. Is that what God is like? The ministry of Jesus does show us what God is like, he is God in human form, and this incident is one of those extravagant moments when Jesus gives us a glimpse of the nature of God's provision for us.

This miracle (or sign as John describes it) tells us a lot, showing how different everything is going to be with Jesus compared to the Old Testament. The Law was given for the nation of Israel, and it was bad news for everybody else. Through this really extravagant miracle, Jesus shows that things have changed. From this point on, the love of God extends to all people, Jews and Gentiles alike, and there is enough grace and mercy to go round, more than enough for everybody - just like the wine.

God of abundant mercy and love, imperfect jars though we may be, you always provide us with more than we ever imagined. Open our eyes to the needs of the world around us and prompt our hearts to cooperate with you. We ask this in the name of your Son, who turned water into wine, Jesus Christ, the worker of miracles. He is Lord forever and ever. Amen.
