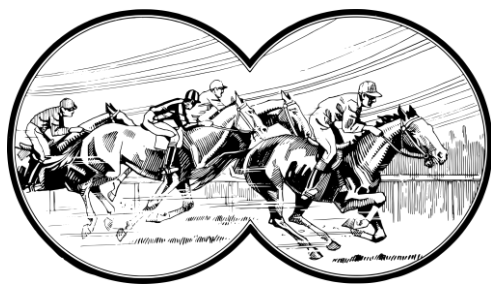

Ruin at the Races

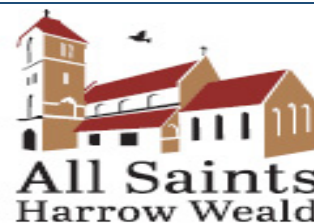


The Fabulous Fakenwin Festival at Fakenwin Racecourse culminates with the Medium Rare Stakes on the final day.

Thought for the week: Vincent of Saragossa (d. c. 304)

Saint Vincent of Saragossa is remembered as a faithful servant of Christ who lived at a very hard and dangerous time for Christians. Vincent was a deacon in the Church. His work was simple but important: helping the bishop, caring for the poor and serving God's people. He lived during a period when the Roman authorities tried to destroy the Christian faith. Believers were ordered to deny Christ or face punishment. Vincent was arrested with his bishop. While the bishop was sent away, Vincent was kept and badly treated. He suffered greatly, yet he did not give up his faith. What is striking is the way he suffered, not with anger or hatred, but with calm trust in God. His quiet courage spoke louder than any words. We remember Saint Vincent on 22 January. His life reminds us that faith is not only about what we say, but about how we live and how we endure difficult moments. Most of us will never face what Vincent faced, but we all know times of pressure, fear, or hardship. Vincent encourages us to stay faithful, to trust God, and to serve others with love, even when it is not easy. **Fr Ninus**
