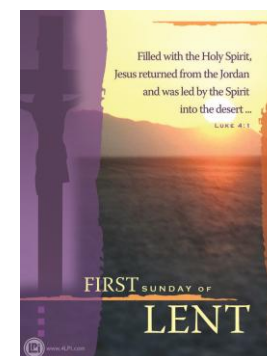

Thought for the week: Finding Our Place in God's Vineyard

On the 27th February the Church remembers George Herbert, priest, poet, and hymn writer, a man who quietly shaped Christian worship in lasting ways. Herbert could have chosen to continue a life of public success, but instead he became a parish priest in a small village. He believed that serving God faithfully, wherever we are placed, is what truly matters. His poems were simple prayers from the heart. Many were later set to music and became hymns, because his words seemed to almost sing on their own. Herbert understood that singing carries faith deep into the soul. A hymn can stay with us long after the service ends. It can comfort us, strengthen us, and remind us of God's presence. Singing is not just something extra in church, it is a form of

ministry. As we also keep the Ember Tide this week, praying for those called to serve, Herbert's life reminds us that God calls each of us. Some are called to ordained ministry. Others serve in quieter ways. And some are called to help lead worship through music and song. Perhaps God's call in your life may even begin with a simple note of song. **Fr Ninus**
