Thought for the week: The Meaning of Incense

At certain services in the Church, incense is used as part of the service. As the thurible is gently swung, fragrant smoke rises and slowly fills the space around the altar. This ancient practice is rich in symbolism and has been part of Christian worship for many centuries. Incense has its roots in the worship of the Old Testament. In the Temple in Jerusalem, incense was offered as part of the prayers of the people. The rising smoke became a powerful symbol of prayer ascending to God. The Book of Psalms reflects this when it says, "Let my prayer rise before you like incense." In the Christian tradition, incense reminds us of that same truth. As the smoke rises upwards, it represents our prayers lifting to heaven. It also helps to mark moments of special reverence in the service, honouring the Gospel, the altar, and the Eucharist. The fragrance itself is also meaningful. It symbolises the holiness and beauty of worship, reminding us that our gathering before God is something sacred.

In this way, incense helps to create a sense of reverence and holiness within our worship. As the fragrant smoke rises, it becomes a visible sign of our prayers offered to God and a reminder of the sacred mystery taking place at the altar. It invites us to slow down, to become attentive, and to recognise that in worship we step into a holy moment. **Fr Ninus**
