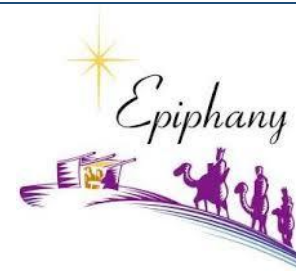

### **Thought for the week: Candlemas. Light in the darkness.**

Life is not always easy. We all face hard times. Some problems we manage to work through. Others feel too hard to bear. It might be money worries, rising bills. It might be broken relationships with friends and family. It might be illness, or the deep sadness of losing someone we love. When these things happen, life can feel unbearable. We can feel lonely, frightened, or worn down, as if no one really understands what we are going through. Candlemas reminds us that we are not on our own. It is the day when Mary and Joseph took the baby Jesus to the Temple. Simeon saw him and said that this child would be a light for the world. Not a light that takes all the trouble away, but a light that stays with us in dark times. Jesus knows what suffering feels like. He lived a real human life. He was tired, afraid, and hurt, just like we are. The Bible says, "Because he himself was tested by what he suffered, he is able to help those who are being tested." (Hebrew 2.18) That means he understands us, because he has been there himself. The light we remember at Candlemas doesn't take all our troubles away, but it stays with us. Even in the darkest times, Jesus walks beside us, offering comfort, strength, and hope. **Fr Ninus**
