Thought for the weekend – Don't panic, trust God instead

The fishing boat that Luke describes in our Holy Gospel reading this weekend would have been a relatively flat-bottomed boat which could be easily pulled up on the beach to unload and used in the shallows along the shore. Great for flexibility, but not good for stability in rough weather. The Sea of Galilee is a relatively small body of water about thirteen miles long and seven miles wide and prone to storms. To be stuck in the middle of the lake in bad weather must have been terrifying. Not surprisingly, the disciples in the boat are petrified when one of these storms breaks upon them, fearing the worst. Only the strongest swimmer would ever be likely to make it to the shore and even that was extremely unlikely from the middle of the lake. In a panic they wake Jesus, who in turn calms the storm, using the same tone and phrases as a teacher might use to get an unruly class under control. Different terrors haunt each one of us. The truth contained in the experience of the disciples on the boat is designed to calm all our fears and enable us to have inner peace. God Himself, through Jesus, invites our spirits to relax and let Him take care of events that are raging beyond our control.

PRAYER FOR THIS WEEKEND: Our prayer for this weekend ties in with the theme of trusting God, not only when our boat is sinking but all the time: Lord, teach me to trust you in whatever situations I may find myself. Help me to pray, not just when my boat is sinking, but in all the times and places of my life where you can make a real difference. Help me with my
