

Thought for the weekend - it doesn't cost us anything to be kind

Very often when we read about the actions of Jesus, we look for theological signs and try to interpret them in ways which help us to understand their deeper meanings. Occasionally, it is also worthwhile to consider them simply at face value, basically as acts of great kindness. In this weekend's gospel reading Jesus sees men who have been fishing all night without a catch. This was a serious business for Simon and his family because it was their livelihood. If there were no fish there was no money and, eventually, no food. Seeing their predicament, Jesus takes them onto the lake and he helps them catch more fish than they could have wished for. This was an action of great kindness, and in response Peter and his brother were ready to give up everything and follow Jesus. Great kindness provoked an enormous response. Who can we be kind to this weekend?

Dear loving heavenly Father, help us to be more understanding and kind towards others. May we see the world through the eyes of those who are suffering and be moved to respond to their needs.
