Thought for the week: Where God Has Placed You

This week the church remembers William Wilberforce, the parliamentarian best known for leading the long campaign to abolish the slave trade. What's easy to forget is that Wilberforce nearly didn't become a politician at all. After his conversion, he seriously considered leaving public life altogether to become a clergyman. It was a friend, John Newton — the former slave-trader turned hymn-writer — who told him to stay exactly where he was. God hadn't saved him to hide in a pulpit. God had placed him in Parliament for a reason.

Wilberforce took that advice, and spent decades using his seat to fight injustice most people had simply accepted. His faith didn't pull him out of public life — it sent him deeper into it.

That's worth sitting with. We can assume the "real" kingdom work happens through clergy, or in church buildings, while everything else is just ordinary life. Wilberforce's story says otherwise.

So, here's a question for Harrow Weald: where has God actually placed you? In a classroom, a business, a hospital ward, a committee room, a family? Wherever it is, that may be exactly where you're called to build the kingdom, not despite where you've been placed, but precisely because of it. **Fr Ninus**
