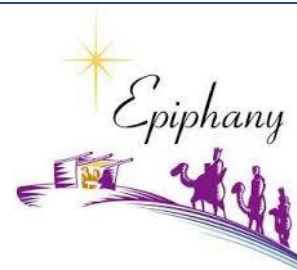

Thought for the week: From a Corruptible to an Incorruptible Crown

On 30 January, the Church remembers King Charles I of England, often called Charles the Martyr. On the day of his death in 1649, standing calmly on the scaffold, he spoke these quiet and striking words: "I go from a corruptible to an incorruptible Crown, where no disturbance can be." His words reflect the hope found in 1 Corinthians 15:52–54, where we are reminded that what is fragile and temporary will one day be changed into something lasting and glorious. Charles had known power, honour, and authority. Yet in his final moments, he recognised that all earthly crowns are temporal. They can be lost, broken, or taken away. What mattered most to him was not the crown on his head, but the promise of life with God. We live in a world that often pushes us to strive for success, approval, and riches. These things can easily become our "crowns". But they do not last. Faith invites us to look beyond them, towards a kingdom that cannot be shaken. As we remember Charles on 30 January, we are gently reminded to examine the crowns we pursue, and to fix our eyes on the one that lasts forever. **Fr Ninus**
