Thought for the weekend – are we blessed or cursed?

In the Monty Python movie "Life of Brian" Jesus goes up on the mountain side to teach the people. There is a huge crowd gathered around him - so huge that some of the people who are on the outer edge of the crowd cannot hear his words and must ask others what the master has said. As Jesus pronounces what we now know as the Beatitudes, one of the characters in the movie is desperate to know what Jesus is saying. He asks a man who is ahead of him the crowd; "what is he saying", what is he saying?" The man checks with a person in front of him, who in turn checks with someone else and then, in classical Chinese whispers style, the message is relayed back, "The Master says blessed are the cheese makers" This is a slightly irreverent reminder to us of how often we can misunderstand what Jesus has said. It is also a way of making us think about who is blessed and who is not. Who really are the blessed ones? Who is it that God favours? Who does God look askance at? Who is it that God warns, even threatens, with troubles and woes? Finally, at a personal level, which of the Beatitudes is speaking directly to us, and why?

PRAYER FOR THIS WEEKEND: this is a prayer to help us to be kind this is a beautiful prayer of Dietrich Bonhoeffer, where he acknowledges our human weaknesses.

God of the day and of the night, in me there is darkness, but with you here is light. I am alone, but you will not leave me. I am weak, but you will come
