Thought for the weekend: are we insiders or outsiders?

This weekend's Holy Gospel challenges the boundaries between the insiders and the outsiders in the entourage surrounding Jesus. As those who follow Jesus, the twelve imagine themselves privileged, they and they only doing God's work. They associate acting in Jesus' name with their own status and power, and feel challenged by someone from outside their circle also acting in Jesus' name! But Jesus doesn't operate with such a them-and-us view of God's activity. It's not about power and status. Jesus looks for what is of God in each one and welcomes it when he finds it, whether or not we belong to a supposed inner circle. When God looks to see what we have; what will he find?
