**Thought for the weekend: Christmas is not necessarily merry for everyone** If we are excited by the hustle and bustle of preparing to celebrate Christmas with loved ones, let us remember that not everybody will be having a wonderful Christmas. There are some people with loved ones in hospital and their journey each day is to visit the sick, not shop in crowded streets. There are others who cannot be happy because of the loss of somebody dear to them and Christmas just makes missing them feel so much worse. Then of course there are others who feel miserable that they cannot enjoy Christmas because it all seems to cost so much money and there just isn't enough to go around. It is important that Christ came as a light because the world which he joined was in darkness. Throughout his life, Jesus was no stranger to pain and suffering, or indeed poverty and hatred from others. If we are feeling miserable this Christmas then perhaps we can be reassured by the words of the one who promises real light, in the midst of what can be a decidedly dark world. As John records in chapter 8 of his gospel, 'Again Jesus spoke to them, saying, "I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will not walk in darkness, but will have the light of life."
